HOST – Volunteering role

Description of a Host

We run (depending on Covid restrictions) 10 to 13 events between February to November. Every second month we do a dinner event at an amazing restaurant in your region.

As a host, you are the face of Where the Wild Women are. Hosts are engaging, supportive and appreciate diversity. Hosts play an especially important role of bringing groups of women together in an open and friendly manner, through encouragement and conversation, building rapport with others quickly and easily.

The host's responsibility is to ensure the members at the event have an amazing time on the day. You will be the first there, and last to leave.

Introductions

You will welcome everyone as they arrive, and mark their names off the list.

Once the group has all arrived you will complete the housekeeping (i.e., signing the declaration, covid 19 sign-ins), and cover off any health and safety.

Before any event starts, complete an ice breaker. These are in your host pack on the private FB group for Hosts and you can choose which one you would like to do. Try to vary it up, so we keep it interesting, and finding out new things about the people in the group.

Event Supervision

You will follow the event process to ensure consistency of experiences for ladies in the groups.

Able to access our event software to get the guest list.

Able to attend at least 4 events per year (out of 10 or 13) between February and November.

Provide feedback back to management about events.

Requirements

Able to attend bi-monthly zoom meeting for training or any matters arising.

Friendly, able to talk to women from all walks of life

Lift up and encourage women

Open to trying various events.
